

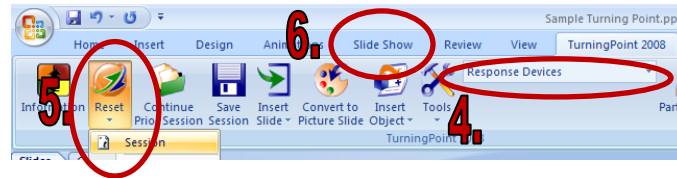


# Using TurningPoint in the Classroom

1. **Insert receiver** into computer's USB port. It is functioning when its green indicator light turns on.
2. Open **TurningPoint 2008** Start>Programs>Turning Technologies 
3. Open your **TurningPoint Presentation** that you have already created (  >Open>[browse to your file])

4. Select **Response Devices** from the dropdown box on your TurningPoint Toolbar.
5. Click on **Reset** and select **Session**
6. Click on **Slide Show** on the PowerPoint Toolbar and then **Start Slideshow from Beginning**



7. Use your **left mouse click** to advance to the first slide
8. A box in the upper right-hand corner will turn green to indicate that **polling is open**; students can click their responses from their response cards and you will see the number of responses increment in the upper corner
9. Your next mouse click will **close the polling**. The green box will turn red and students may no longer vote. Results of the polling will be displayed.



10. If desired, you may **save the results of your polling**



## RETURN TO LIBRARY CHECKLIST:
