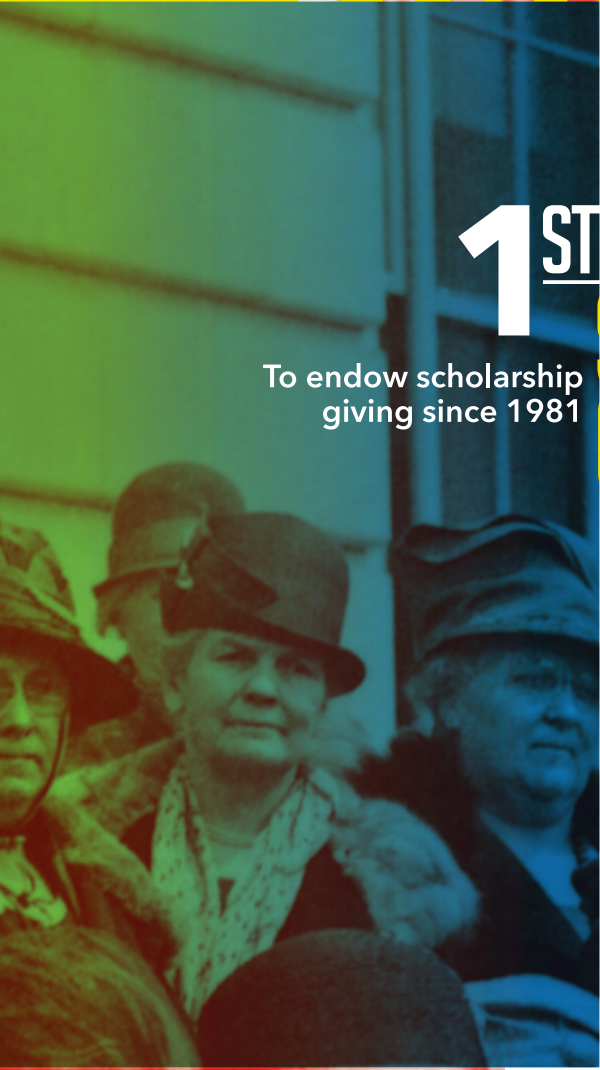



With a grant from the Rose Foundation's Puget Sound Stewardship and Mitigation Fund, GRC's Natural Resources program launched an Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) project to survey and map the watershed, preparing a new generation of stewards for the future of land management.
