



# 2017 Income Tax Filing for International Students

Anyone who earns income in the United States is required to file and pay taxes to the federal government. However, international students must follow special regulations when paying taxes on their income. **In general, international students that worked and earned income during 2017 and your income was more than the [personal exemption amount](#), you must file your income taxes by the deadline, which is April 17, 2018.**

## What Forms to Fill Out

Typically F-1 students who have been here less than 5 years would be considered nonresident aliens for tax purposes and would complete/file two forms: (view [Taxation of Nonresidents](#))

1. [Form 8843](#) – this form is an informational statement required by the U.S. Internal Revenue Service (IRS) for nonresidents, simply telling the U.S. government that you were in the U.S. (*see page 2 of the form for instructions*)
2. [Form 1040 NR-EZ](#) (with no dependents) **OR** [Form 1040-NR](#) (with dependents) - You will complete *one* of the 1040NR forms using a W-2, a 1042-S, or a 1099 form that you receive by mail.
