- Please communicate to the students that if, after the quarter starts, they feel their math class is too challenging they should speak with their instructor about correct placement.
  - Before taking an Entrance Exam:
    - a) To get familiar with the test format before testing, all students should take a sample Entrance Exam.
    - b) Sample tests are available for free in WAMAP at [greenriver.edu/placement/wamap](http://greenriver.edu/placement/wamap).
  - Review options to assist in preparing to test for higher placement:
    - a) Self-study material are available for free in WAMAP at [greenriver.edu/placement/wamap](http://greenriver.edu/placement/wamap).
    - b) 2-credit supplement courses for 62, 70, 72, 97, or 141 can assist students reviewing to prepare for an Entrance Exam. They are called Math Module (MATHM 62, 70, 72, 97, or 141) and Jump Start (MATHJ 62, 70, 72, 97, or 141) classes. ALEX software is used including an initial diagnostic assessment to develop an individualized learning pathway. Courses are pass/no credit.
  - Acceleration options:
    - a) Hybrid 62, 70, and 72 allow students to accelerate and complete 62/70, 70/72, or 72/97 in one quarter by choosing to work faster. They earn 5-credits for the highest class they complete. Hawkes software is used.
    - b) An accelerated face-to-face 72/97 class allows students to complete both courses in one quarter. The 10-credit learning community class is taught fall quarter only.



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Some CTE courses may be taken in lieu of Advanced Algebra/Trig in the Auburn School District. Find placement using the CTE course taken in high school, the final grade in the course (2nd semester grade in a year-long course), and the time since completing it.
