<p>Step 1</p> <p>Who is eligible for TRiO?</p>	<p>You must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident • Have a high school diploma or GED • Be pursuing a transfer degree to a four-year school • Be currently enrolled in 10 or more credits at Green River – 5 of which are college level • Have a 2.0 cumulative GPA <hr/> <p>You also need to meet at least one of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be a first-generation college student (neither parent has received a four-year college degree); or • Meet low-income federal guidelines; or • Have a documented disability
