	Application (Toccs)
Step 1	You <u>must</u> :
Who is eligible for TRiO?	Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident
	Have a high school diploma or GED
	Be pursuing a transfer degree to a four-year school
	Be currently enrolled in 10 or more credits at Green River – 5 of which are college level
	Have a 2.0 cumulative GPA
	You also need to meet at least one of the following criteria:
	Be a first-generation college student (neither parent has received a four-year college degree); or
	Meet low-income federal guidelines; or
	Have a documented disability
NOTE: If you have already earned a degree, please let us know	
Step 2	Completely fill out the application
Apply for TRiO	Attach a copy of your income documents:
Student Support Services	 If you are <u>independent</u> for financial aid purposes, include your signed income tax return for the most current tax year
	 If you are <u>dependent</u> for financial aid purposes, please include your information as well as your parent(s)/guardian(s)' signed income tax return for the most current tax year
