

ATTESTATION FOR REINSTATEMENT OF WASHINGTON STATE FUNDING

Washington state no longer requires repayment of disbursed financial aid monies from state grants or scholarships when a student's enrollment level changes during the first two weeks of the quarter. These programs include but are not limited to the Washington College Grant, the College Bound Scholarship, and Passport to Careers. Although you do not have to repay either the amount that was applied to your tuition and fees or the amount that was disbursed to you directly, it is important to understand the impact. If you choose not to repay the amount, the full amount you received will be deducted from your remaining lifetime eligibility for these funding sources. You will also not be eligible to receive future funding from any of these state grants or scholarships until you complete and submit this attestation to the Financial Aid Office of Green River College.

By signing this form, I agree to the following:

- I started participating in all the classes in which I was enrolled for this quarter as of the day my financial aid was applied. Since then, I have dropped one or more classes. I understand that this has impacted my enrollment level and therefore the amount of financial aid for which I qualify.
- I choose not to return these funds from Washington state programs. I understand that this will impact my lifetime eligibility for funding from Washington state grants and scholarships.
- I understand that if I do not complete this form, my Washington state grants and scholarships will be canceled until I submit a completed copy.
- I understand that the GRC Financial Aid staff have the authority to deny this reinstatement. If this happens, I will not be eligible for additional state funding until I successfully complete one quarter (minimum of 5 credits) without state funding. I have the ability to appeal this decision.
- I understand that this attestation is only valid for reinstating my eligibility for state funding. It is possible that I will have federal funding (such as Pell grants) that I have to repay. Additionally, if I have failed to meet the Satisfactory Academic Progress standards, I will have to submit a separate appeal for that in accordance with GRC policy.
