

Distance Placement Proctoring Request



Process

Students seeking to complete a placement assessment for Green River College and currently not residing within driving distance may request distance proctoring at a local college or university or online via ProctorU. Once the test is completed, the scores will be sent to Green River.

Students who are taking the WAMAP Math Entrance Exam should go to www.greenriver.edu/wamap and follow the steps to access the review courses to help them determine the appropriate level at which to test, indicate this level in the space provided below.

ProctorU charges fees based on the length of the exams. Additional proctoring fees may also apply at the selected location at the time of testing.
