The Concentration in Communication Studies is a 20-credit program designed to encourage students to explore several courses and disciplines within the field of communication studies.

Students may choose to complete this concentration of study and have it posted to their transcript **ONLY** when the student successfully completes the Associate in Arts-Direct Transfer Agreement (AA-DTA) degree. Otherwise courses taken will transfer to four year universities on a course by course basis only.

Students are urged to consult with their Green River advisor to plan their programs of study. Students are also urged to consult with a representative from the university they plan to attend.

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Courses used to fulfill requirements in one section may not also be used to fulfill requirements in another section.
