Overview of Nursing & Healthcare Industry Roles

Assistant/Technician: Narrow scope of work, with specific skills. Provides basic patient care under supervision, assisting with daily activities and monitoring health. Examples include nursing assistant, emergency room technician, and phlebotomist. Licensing typically requires completion of a certificate program.

Practical Nurse (PN): Delivers direct patient care under supervision, focusing on hands-on skills, patient interaction, and care team collaboration. Licensing requires completion of an Associate of Applied Science in Practical Nursing degree.

Registered Nurse (RN): Coordinates patient care, administers medications, educates patients, and collaborates with healthcare providers. Licensing requires completion of an Associates Degree in Nursing or an Bachelors of Science in Nursing degree.

Nurse Practitioner (NP): Diagnoses and treats illnesses, prescribes medications, and educates patients, often specializing in specific areas. Licensing requires completion of a masters or doctoral program.

Nursing Specialty: Once an individual achieves nursing licensure, specialization often occurs through on-the-job training, experience, and further education. For example, labor and delivery, ICU, and ER nurses.

Everyone Starts Here

- 1. Apply to Green River College by going to greenriver.edu/applynow
- 2. Follow Next Steps: After your application is processed, you will receive an email with general onboarding instructions for the College, including Online Orientation, and English/math placement.

LPN or BSN Degree Seeking Students

- 3. Complete all prerequisites; 9 courses for LPN. 12 courses plus LPN program completion for BSN.
- 4. SUBMIT OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS EARLY FOR EVALUATION WITH TRANSCRIPT EVALUATION REQUEST FORM.
 - Only if you have completed prerequisites outside of Green River College.
- 5. Apply to LPN or BSN program once prerequisites are finished. Both programs have competitive admissions.
- 6. If offered admission, attend orientation, register for and attend program courses.

Certificate Seeking Students

- 3. Go to greenriver.edu/nhs, find your certificate program and apply online.
- 4. Check Your Email: Once your application is processed, you will receive your next steps.
- 5. Attend the required orientation, register for and attend program courses.

Green River Certificate Pathways

Green River offers three healthcare certificate programs that meet state licensure standards and develop role-specific skills, preparing graduates to enter the workforce after passing required exams and applying for licensure. These programs are a strong option for students exploring healthcare or professionals seeking to expand their skills.

Certificate Program Requirements

In order to participate in Green River College's Nursing & Healthcare Studies certificate programs, students must meet the following requirements.

English Proficiency

Qualify for TS Level 6 (ENGL 97+ or reading score 61+ on the College Success Reading Assessment).

Background Check

Must pass; some convictions may prevent participation—check with NHS Program Manager. Do not run your own check.

Age Requirement

Must be 18 within 3 months of graduation; State requires individuals are 18 at the time of licensure.

Drug Screening

May be required by clinical sites; includes marijuana testing. Testing depends on student's clinical site.

Emergency Room & Patient Care Technician | Average Wage: \$48,853 | 8.8% Projected Growth

Common Job Duties: Take vital signs, assist with daily activities, document care, support and transport patients, aid in trauma and wound care, assist with procedures, and prioritize patient needs. Eligible for FAFSA/WASFA, and Workforce funding.

Bachelors of Science in Nursing | BSN-RN Average Wage: \$111,838 | RN 5.8% Projected Growth

Prepares LPNs for careers as Bachelor's-prepared RNs through a 90-credit curriculum with classroom, lab, and clinical work, leading to eligibility for graduates to sit for the NCLEX-RN. Eligible for FAFSA/WASFA and Workforce funding.

Program Requirements: Active practical nursing license, current immunizations (no exemptions), and completion of all prerequisites; one may be outstanding at the time of application.

AAS in Practical Nursing | PN Average Wage: \$79,221 | PN 7.2% Projected Growth

Prepares students for LPN careers through a 90-credit program (includes 45 credits of prerequisite. Graduates can sit for the NCLEX-PN. Pathway to ADN, BSN, and advanced degrees. Eligible for FAFSA/WASFA and Workforce funding.

Program Requirements: Current immunizations (no exemptions) and completion of all prerequisites with at least a 2.5 in each course and a 3.0+ cumulative prerequisite GPA; one course may be outstanding at the time of application.

Immunizations & Medical Tests

All Nursing programs (except Phlebotomy) require completed immunizations and medical tests, with no exemptions. NHS Staff will assist students in meeting these requirements during orientation and the first weeks of the quarter.


- 1. TDAP: Required every 10 years.
- 2. MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella): Provide proof of vaccination (2 doses) or titer for all three.
- 3. Hepatitis B: 3 injections which take approximately 6 months. Titer is required after being fully vaccinated.
- 4. Varicella: Provide proof of vaccination (2 doses) or titer. A history of chickenpox is not accepted as proof.
- 5. TB Test: Option 1 is a 2-step TB Test. Option 2 is a QuantiFERON blood draw.
- 6. COVID-19: Pre-September 2023 okay for certificate programs. Booster shot after September 2023 is required for LPN and BSN program.
- 7. Flu: When available

Green River AAS and BSN Prerequisite Courses

Completion of the courses below is required prior to entering Green River's AAS and BSN degree programs. Applicants may have one unfinished prerequisite that is in progress (student is enrolled-in) at the time of application. Please note:

- minimum prerequisite course GPA is 2.5
- minimum cumulative prerequisite GPA is 3.0+
- · courses do not expire
- · no course retake limit
- Your math & English placement may require additional courses.
