



MA-Phlebotomy Checklist

Application to Green River Community College

18 Years of Age or Older

- You must have valid photo ID (driver's license or any state-issued photo ID). Required to provide a photocopy at mandatory orientation.

High School Diploma or GED

- At the time of licensure application, the Washington State Department of Health may require documentation of high school completion or its equivalency.

Eligibility for English 101

- Students must be eligible for ENGL& 101 as demonstrated by taking the college placement tests or providing a transcript demonstrating eligibility. Required to provide a photocopy at mandatory orientation. (Transcript or documentation from Assessment and Testing Center).

Signed Background Check Attestation

- A criminal record may possibly prohibit a student from obtaining state licensure. The Washington State Department of Health will obtain background checks for licensure purposes through the Washington State Patrol and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. While, Green River does not run a criminal background check on students, they are highly encouraged to visit: <https://www.dshs.wa.gov/fsa/background-check-central-unit/disqualifying-list-crimes-and-negative-actions> for a list of certain criminal convictions, pending charges, and negative actions that automatically disqualify a person from having unsupervised access to vulnerable adults, juveniles, and children. Bring this with you to the mandatory orientation.

HOW TO ENROLL IN THE PROGRAM:

Attend Mandatory Orientation

- Here you will meet the faculty and staff, submit required paperwork and learn about the program. You must attend the mandatory orientation session and turn-in all the completed documentation to be enrolled in the course.
