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CLASS TYPE DEFINITION

- **ONLINE:** The entire class will be held online without a set time to attend. The class will still have assignment deadlines and due dates.

HOW IT WORKS: After you register, you will receive an email from UGotClass with a web address to access your online classroom. Once inside the online classroom, here's what you can expect: Participate When You Want. The online classroom is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week. There are no live real-time requirements or meetings.

WHAT YOU WILL DO: For each unit of the course, you will: Access the online readings, Listen to the audio presentation and view the slides, Take a self-quiz to see how much you have learned, Engage in written online discussion with your instructor and other participants. Your instructor will log into the discussion area at least once a day and answer questions, make comments, and respond to comments by you and the other participants.

COMPLETION REQUIREMENTS: 1. Make at least one thoughtful comment, beyond I agree, every week in the discussion. 2. Take the self-quiz at the end of every unit and score 80% or higher—these can be retaken to pass.

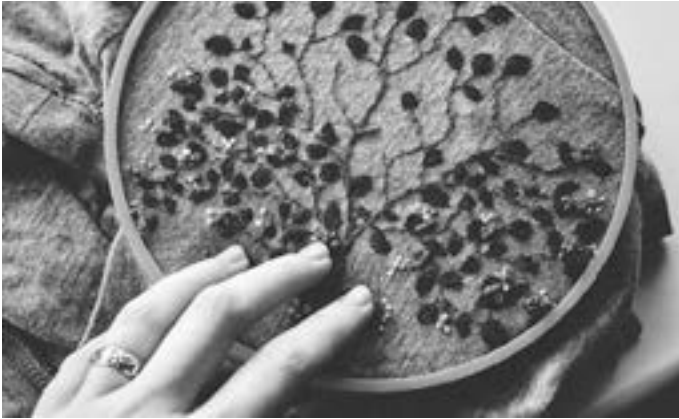

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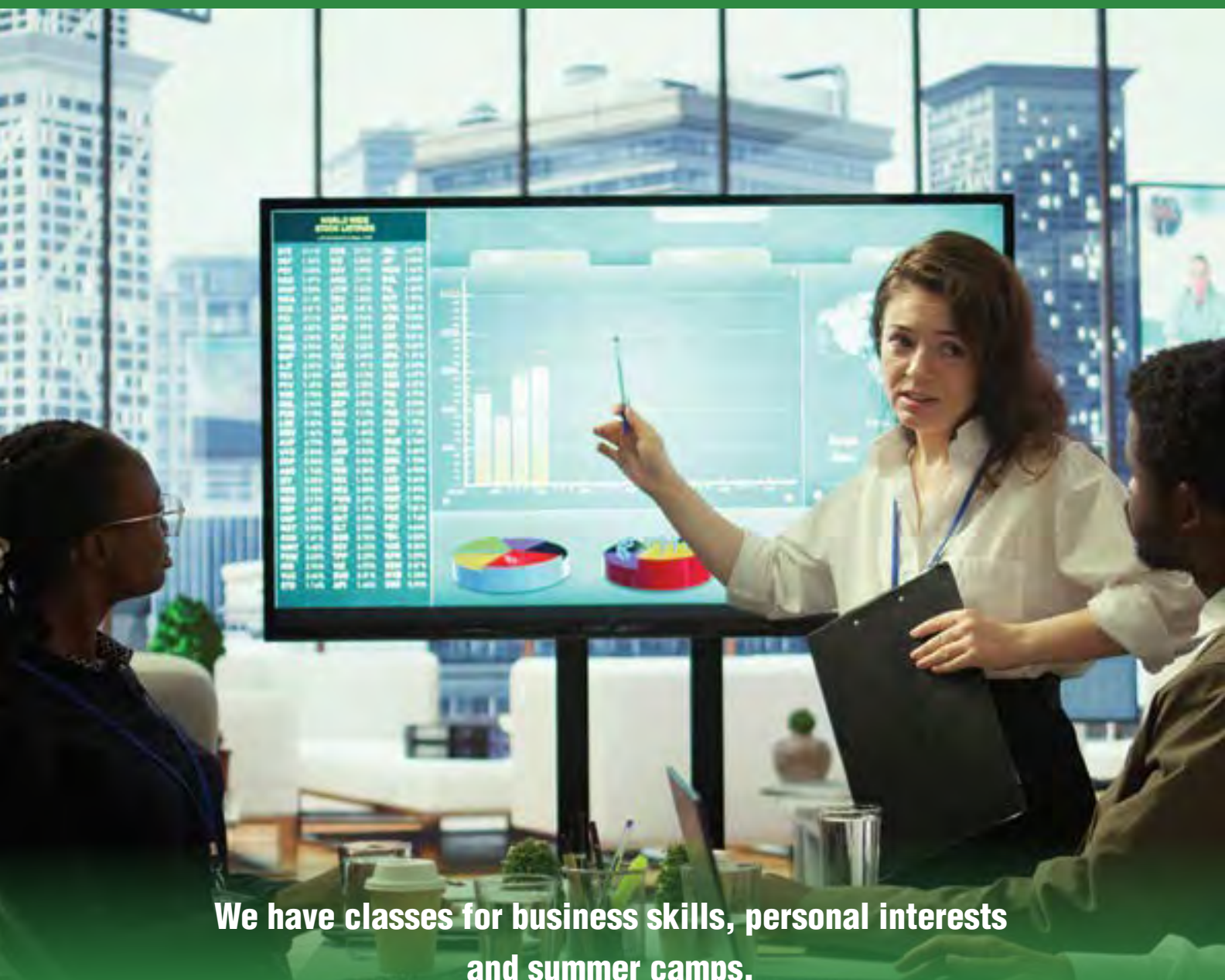
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
